

8.08.015 Portable Open Flame Roasters:

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a portable open flame roaster which does not comply with the following regulations.

Portable open flame roasters must be:

1. located a minimum of 15 feet from any structure, building, pedestrian walkway or street.
2. fueled by a storage tank approved by the New Mexico Construction Industries Department
3. connected, stabilized and located not less than 10 feet from the source of fuel by a steel pipe buried or placed flat on a hard, non flammable surface which is equipped with no more than 2-12 inch risers, and a quick action shut-off valve.
4. the fuel source must be equipped with a factory-set regulator.
5. any non-metal connectors shall not come in contact with the ground and shall be kept free of any flammable material.
6. be equipped with an approved fire extinguisher on site
7. must be supervised by an adult at all times while in operation
8. be located in a area kept clean of trash or other flammable materials

For the purpose of this ordinance, "portable" means any object not permanently attached to the property. (Ord. ??? § 8.080.15, 2006)
